



I thought it would be a good idea to put some info here to answer some of the questions we've been asked. We'll add to this document as time goes on, but here's a start!

Can I bring a trailer?

Yes you can, but there is only very limited space at Jubilee Park to keep it there unless you are going to display the car on the trailer. Arrangements have been made for additional parking for your trailer about 15 minutes drive from the park. Mail me at lincolnshire@countywheels.uk for further details.

Can I bring an event tent?

Yes you can. We are limited for space and don't really want Tent City, but assuming that you have a standard one it will be 15' x 15'. You will need to make the tent allowance of two car spaces from your space allocation unless you are going to display cars within the tent. So if you need space allocating for an event tent and 6 cars you'll need to send me a cheque for EIGHT car spaces (ie: £32) and also please let me know that you have allowed two spaces for the tent so that I can issue the correct number of passes. There is space provided for all this information on the application form which you can download from the lower button at the bottom of the Lincolnshire page.

How do you want the entry form and cheque sent to you?

Please send the completed form and a cheque for all the spaces you need in one go if you can. Quite often just after you've sent everything off to us someone else asks for a ticket! If you need further tickets and to send a further cheque, don't worry, we can deal with that, just complete a second form and cheque and we'll sort the rest out for you.

We have looked into other methods of payment but these are expensive to set up and would make a big hole in our charity donation, so I'm afraid, for now, its just cheques we accept.

How do I deal with member's payments where club cheques are a problem?

What I do for the club I am organising is to collect the cash and keep it and then write a personal cheque out for County Wheels. We don't have a local club bank account, so getting a cheque from head office (lovely as they are!!) would be a bit of a pain!!

When will you be sending out the club passes?

We have these ready at the start of the new year. After that, we plan to send them out as we get your forms & cheques in and to email them to organisers as pdf's for forwarding to your members.

What happens if someone wants to join our club collection after the TWO WEEK cut-off?

I'm afraid that we'll have the spaces allocated as soon after the cut-off date as possible as we need to get the plans printed in time for the day, so they will have to park wherever and to pay £5.00 at the gate on the day. Sorry!
